Your Carpet Cleaning & Maintenance Schedule

Why to do it	What to use	How often	What to do	End result
If not done, all surface dirt and dust will be too abrasive for your carpet, as a result it will need to be replaced sooner.	Good quality multi filter vacuum cleaner	At least weekly	Vacuum your carpets throughout, pay more attention to high traffic area/s	Most of surface dirt and some dust will be removed from your carpet surface
To change natural flow of traffic on your carpets	No specific tools required	Every 6- 12 months	Change your furniture layout	Better carpets
To change amount of dirt that is "walked in"	Broom, Vacuum cleaner, mop	At least weekly	Clean surrounding hard surfaces, especially entrance/s	Cleaner surrounding areas, and carpet
To reduce level of carpet soiling	Floor mats and rugs	One off but need to be maintained clean	Place entrance mats and rugs in high traffic areas	Cleaner carpets
To remove stains, remove dirt, dust, skin particles and to revitalise your entire carpet	Professional Carpet Steam Cleaning Company	Depending on carpet use- Commercial at least every 6-8 months, Domestic- annually	Call 1300 022 532 to make booking for carpet steam cleaning service	Cleaner air, no stains, no odour and refreshing look of your carpet
Reduce carpet pile compression, stains from furniture and deep indentation	Furniture caps and pads	One off	Place your heavy furniture items on furniture caps and pads when re arranging layout	Better carpet
